



Amidst the past 2 years, we know that we, along with many other clubs, are looking for methods to safely transition Lions back into consistent and effective in-person service projects. The West London Lions Club is excited to share a summer fundraiser for Orbis Canada with you! Orbis is an international NGO that focuses primarily on the prevention of blindness and the treatment of blinding eye diseases, particularly in developing countries. They have a number of innovative, first-of-their-kind technologies and services to facilitate travel, assist with training local ophthalmology staff, and help people with reversible blindness. In 2021, we hosted our first fundraiser with Orbis where we were able to raise over \$3200. Given the success of the first fundraiser, we decided to host a second fundraising event with Orbis by creating a Canada Lions for Orbis team for their **Plane Pull for Sight** event! The event involves a friendly competition between other teams at the event to see who can pull a plane 20ft the fastest. In conjunction, we will be hosting a virtual charity run that will be held concurrently with the Plane Pull for Sight on **September 25th** for Lions who were not their club's nominee. Participating members will be asked to walk or run between **1 to 5 km** and have their respective clubs donate in support of the cause and the participants. We are asking for any individual donations from your club members and/or a club donation of \$100-\$250. For clubs that donate 200\$ or more, we welcome them to nominate a member to join our team for the in person Plane Pull for Sight Event in Toronto on September 25.
